

in each fiscal year on account of such fees, said amount to be used for deficits incurred by reason of emergency, free or charitable work; and for maintenance of and repairs to the hospital building heretofore provided for, the grounds thereof and the equipment and furnishings therein, including the replacement of worn or obsolete furnishings or equipment with new furnishings and equipment and the acquisition of new equipment not previously considered necessary. After the payment of said sums, the Clerk shall thereafter pay to the Treasurer of North Beach the next ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) received in each fiscal year on account of such fees, said amount to be held by the said Treasurer in a special fund to be used for the purpose of enlarging, extending and improving the sewage, storm water drainage and/or water supply systems of the town of North Beach, including the construction of additional disposal and filter plants, pumping stations, reservoirs, conduits and other appurtenances, the alteration, repair and improvement of such present facilities, and the purchase or lease of land, easements, franchises or other interests as may be authorized for such purpose. The remainder of such funds shall be paid to the Treasurer of Calvert County Hospital of Calvert County, Maryland, or to such person or corporation as the Board of Directors may designate, until a sufficient sum shall have been paid to liquidate the present mortgage indebtedness against the said Calvert County Hospital in the amount of \$110,000.00 incurred for the construction thereof, together with interest thereon at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum from and after January 1, 1953, until paid. Such payments shall be made over a period of five years, and no payment shall be greater than Twenty-six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000) in any one calendar year.

(b) Any surplus from said funds after application as provided for in sub-section (a) of this section, shall be distributed as follows: for a period of five years from and after June 1, 1953, any such surplus shall be devoted by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County to the liquidation of a deficit in the current operating revenues of the Board of Education of Calvert County as found to exist by the State Department of Education in March, 1953. Thereafter any such surplus shall be paid into the General Funds of Calvert County to be expended for the general purposes of the said county.]

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or permit the operation of any unlicensed amusement machine or device authorized to be licensed under this sub-title, or to permit any machine or device so authorized to be licensed to be operated or played by any person under sixteen years of age or for such minor to operate such machine or device. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of \$50.00 for the first offense and
