~~(A) MARYLAND SERVICES FOR THE BLIND IS THE SOLE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VOCATIONAL AND OTHER REHABILITATION OF THE BLIND AND SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION FOR THE BLIND IN THIS STATE. IN THIS CONNECTION, MARYLAND SERVICES FOR THE BLIND SHALL ESTABLISH, CONDUCT, OR MAINTAIN ONE OR MORE REHABILITATION CENTERS TO TEACH BLIND PERSONS, TO PREPARE BLIND PERSONS FOR AND TO ASSIST THEM TO SECURE AND MAINTAIN TRADES OR OCCUPATIONS, AND TO PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT FOR BLIND PERSONS.~~

~~(B) ALL POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS OF THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL REHABILITATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AS THEY RELATE TO OR AFFECT BLIND PERSONS, ARE TRANSFERRED TO MARYLAND SERVICES FOR THE BLIND, TOGETHER WITH ALL CONTRACTS, PERSONNEL, RECORDS, REPORTS, DOCUMENTS, BOOKS, PAPERS OR OTHER WRITINGS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT WHICH PERTAIN TO THE POWERS, DUTIES, FUNCTIONS, AND ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAMS OR SERVICES FOR THE BLIND.~~

~~(C) ALL UNEXPENDED OR UNREIMBURSED FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL REHABILITATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RELATING TO PROGRAMS FOR THE BLIND ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED TO MARYLAND SERVICES FOR THE BLIND. ALL TRANSFERS OF FUNDS OR TANGIBLE PROPERTY SHALL BE EXECUTED AS EFFICIENTLY AND EXPEDITIOUSLY AS POSSIBLE. MARYLAND SERVICES FOR THE BLIND MAY ADOPT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ITS POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.~~

~~Any blind person of the age of 18 years or more, desiring to operate a legitimate business of any kind to provide a livelihood for himself and dependents, if any, may apply to [Blind Industries and Services of] Maryland SERVICES FOR THE BLIND.~~

~~[Blind Industries and Services of] Maryland SERVICES FOR THE BLIND shall have authority to issue licenses to blind persons who are citizens of the United States and at least 18 years of age, for the operation of stands in all State, county and municipal buildings, including buildings~~
