CHAPTER 700

(Senate Bill 764)

AN ACT concerning

Mental Health - Emergency Admissions

FOR the purpose of changing certain procedures for filing a petition for emergency admissions to emergency facilities; providing for procedures for peace officers accompanying emergency admittees; changing certain criteria for admission; providing for the costs of transportation of admittees; and generally revising procedures and criteria for emergency admissions of persons suffering from mental disorders.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 59 - Mental Hygiene

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 59 - Mental Hygiene

(d) (3) No certificate shall be executed by any physician financially interested, by reason of ownership or ~~salary~~ COMPENSATION, in any [private] PROPRIETARY facility in which it is proposed to admit the person whose status is being certified, nor may such physician be related by blood or marriage to either the prospective patient or the applicant.
