 - the design of the complex shall be such that, (aa) through appropriate architectural design, setbacks and/or landscaping, Biddle Street is aesthetically and securely buffored from any structures used for the housing of prisoners, and (bb) if any new buildings of more than four stories are constructed for the housing of prisoners, they shall be located as far on the site as practicable from the mearby communities;
