Biddle Street, Baltimore, the State shall receive the fair market value for said property.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the aggregate principal amount of the loan authorized by Chapter 671 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby reduced by the sum of \$21,000,000.

SECTION 2 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act are not coverable, and if any provision of this Act is declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, or is otherwise precluded from taking effect, then this Act shall be null and void in its entirety.

CHAPTER 708

(Senate Bill 1128)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Police Department - Attorney

FOR the purpose of repealing the provision that the Attorney General of Maryland shall be the attorney for and represent the Police Department and the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City; repealing certain duties of the Attorney General which pertain to the Baltimore City Police Department; and repealing references to the Attorney General's Office in the Baltimore City Police Department grievance procedure.
