- (D) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE HOSPITAL OR OTHER PACILITY SECRETARY OR HIS DESIGNEE MAY TERMINATE THE COMMITMENT AT ANY TIME AFTER 96 HOURS AFTER 96 HOURS UPON HIS DETERMINATION THAT FURTHER CONTINUED COMMITMENT WILL NOT BE IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE PATIENT OR SERVE ANY USEFUL PURPOSE.
- (F) IN THE CASE OF A USER OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, THE COMMITMENT SHALL BE MADE BY THE JUDGE ONLY AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MENTAL HOSPITAL TO WHICH THE COMMITMENT IS TO BE MADE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE. THE COMMITTING COURT SHALL BE NOTIFIED BY THE SECRETARY OR HIS DESIGNEE OF THE PROPOSED RELEASE DATE AND TIME OF RELEASE PRIOR TO THAT RELEASE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 712

(House Bill 288)

AN ACT concerning

State Lottery - State Lottery Fund

FOR the purpose of changing the time of payment of lottery revenues into the general funds of the State beginning with a certain fiscal year so that the State's share shall be accumulated in the Fund on a monthly basis for transfer to the general funds on a monthly basis.
