

(4) WITHIN A FACILITY DESIGNED AND REGULARLY TESTED SO AS TO SAFELY ACCOMPLISH THE LONG TERM STORAGE OF NUCLEAR WASTE MATERIAL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 715

(House Bill 347)

AN ACT concerning

Practice of Electrology

FOR the purpose of establishing a State Board of Electrologists; providing for the composition of the Board; delineating the powers and duties of the Board; providing for the operation and procedures of the Board; requiring licensing of certain individuals; establishing licensing qualifications, fees, and procedures; providing for education programs and examinations; providing for the discipline of licensees; prohibiting certain acts; imposing certain criminal penalties; providing for the termination of the Board; and relating generally to the practice of electrology; and making this Act an emergency measure.
