(A) IN GENERAL.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD HAS THE FOLLOWING POWERS AND DUTIES:

- (1) TO ADOPT STANDARDS FOR THE PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY:
- (2) TO APPROVE INSTRUMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR USE IN THE PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY;
- (3) TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE:
 - (4) TO KEEP RECORDS OF ITS PROCEEDINGS:
- (5) TO KEEP A CURRENT LIST OF LICENSED FLECTROLOGISTS AND LICENSED INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGISTS;
- (6) TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND SECRETARY;
- (7) TO ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS;
- (8) TO REFER TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY ANY ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE CRIMINAL PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE:
- (9) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, TO INCUR ANY NECESSARY FXPENSE THAT RELATES TO THE REFERRAL OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE CRIMINAL PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE: AND
- (10) TO REVIEW ADVERTISING BY ANY LICENSEE OF ANY INSTITUTION APPROVED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) PUBLIC MEMBERS.

EXCEPT FOR THE POWER TO GRADE EXAMINATIONS, A PUBLIC MEMBER HAS ALL THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF ANY OTHER BOARD MEMBER.

144-10. ESTABLISHMENT OF FFES; DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

(A) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

- (1) FXCEPT FOR THOSE FEES SPECIFICALLY SET BY THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY SET FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND PENEWAL OF LICENSES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.
- (2) THE PEES CHARGED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE SET TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD.
 - (B) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.
