

EACH LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD SHALL INDICATE WHETHER IT IS:

- (1) AN ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE; OR
- (2) AN INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE.

144-19. PRIOR LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS OF THIS SECTION, ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS LICENSED AS AN ELECTROLOGIST OR INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST BY THE STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS ON JUNE 30, 1978 SHALL BE ISSUED A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE WITHOUT EXAMINATION.

(B) CONDITIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE APPLICANT:

- (1) IS OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER; AND
- (2) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD BY OCTOBER 31, 1979:
 - (I) AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT IT REQUIRES;
 - (II) EVIDENCE OF THE PRIOR LICENSE; AND
 - (III) THE LICENSE FEE OF \$50.

144-20. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

(1) AN ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(2) AN INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY AND TO TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

144-21. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE EXPIRES ON OCTOBER 31 AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE TERM OF A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO HIS LAST KNOWN ADDRESS, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT CONTAINS A STATEMENT OF:
