(I) TO CARRY OUT AN EDUCATION PROGRAM IN THE THEORY OF ELECTROLOGY THAT CONSISTS OF AT LEAST 20 HOURS OF ACADEMIC LECTURING TO BE TAUGHT IN AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING BY A PHYSICIAN: OR

(II) TO CARRY OUT AN EDUCATION PROGRAM IN THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY THAT CONSISTS OF AT LEAST 80 HOURS OF TRAINING TO BE TAUGHT BY A LICENSED INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST; AND

(III) TO MEET THE STANDARDS SET BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) CONTINUING REVIEW.

- (1) THE BOARD PERIODICALLY MAY EVALUATE ELECTROLOGY PROGRAMS IN THIS STATE AND PREPARE A WRITTEN REPORT.
- (2) THE BOARD SHALL GIVE SPECIFIC WRITTEN NOTICE TO AN APPROVED INSTITUTION OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

144-30. WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL.

(A) GROUNDS FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL.

THE BOARD MAY REMOVE AN INSTITUTION FROM ITS LIST OF APPROVED SCHOOLS IF THE INSTITUTION:

- (1) IS GUILTY OF FRAUD OR DECEIT IN OBTAINING OR ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN APPROVAL:
- (2) ACTS IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED STANDARDS OF ELECTROLOGY PRACTICE:
- (3) ADVERTISES IN A MANNER THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES VIOLATES THE STANDARDS OF $\frac{6}{5}$ $\frac{1434-4}{4}$ $\frac{6}{5}$ $\frac{144-34}{4}$ OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR
- (4) VIOLATES THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AND THE VIOLATION IS NOT CORRECTED IN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER NOTICE IS GIVPN.
 - (B) HEARINGS AND PROCEDURE.

ANY ACTION TAKEN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 144-24 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
