144-34. ADVERTISING.

A LICENSEE OR AN INSTITUTION THAT IS APPROVED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY ADVERTISE IN ANY MANNER THAT IS REASONABLE AND NOT MISLEADING OR FRAUDULENT.

PART VI. PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES.

144-35. PRACTICING WITHOUT LICENSE.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT PRACTICE, ATTEMPT TO PRACTICE, OR OFFER TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY OR TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY IN THIS STATE UNLESS LICENSED BY THE BOARD.

144-36. MISREPRESENTATION.

UNLESS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY OR TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF TO THE PUBLIC BY TITLE, BY DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, METHODS, OR PROCEDURES, OR OTHERWISE, AS A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY IN THIS STATE.

144-37. RESERVED.

144-38. RESERVED.

144-39. PENALTIES.

ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS PART OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.

PART VII. SHORT TITLE; TERMINATION OF SUBTITLE.

144-40. SHORT TITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "ELECTROLOGY PRACTICE ACT".

144-41. TERMINATION OF SUBTITLE.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE REGULATORY PROGRAMS EVALUATION ACT OF 1978 (ARTICLE 41, SUBTITLE 48), THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND OF ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 1984.
