(B) TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY AND COMPATIBILITY OF PLANNING DATA, SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION AND FUNDING, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE IN FOREST RESOUCE PLANNING EFFORTS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE FOREST AND RANGELANDS RENEWABLE RESOURCES PLANNING ACT OF 1974 AND THE COOPERATIVE FORESTRY ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1978.

- (A) IN THIS PART, THE POLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "URBAN AND COMMUNITY AREAS" MEANS AN EXISTING OR PLANNED COMMUNITY DEVELOPED FOR RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, OR INDUSTRIAL USES.
- (C) -- URBAN-COMMUNITY FORESTRY MEANS THE PLANNING, ESTABLISHMENT, PROTECTION, AND MANAGEMENT OF FORESTS AND TREES AND ASSOCIATED VEGETATION IN URBAN AND COMMUNITY AREAS.

- (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT TRRES AND FORESTS IMPROVE THE ENVIRONMENT IN URBAN AREAS. THE PLANTING, PROTECTION, AND MAINTENANCE OF TREES AND FORESTS AND THE UTILIZATION OF WOOD FROM PRUNED AND DAMACED TREES IN URBAN AREAS MAKES THOSE AREAS A MORE ATTRACTIVE AND HEALTHPUL PLACE TO LIVE, WORK, AND VISIT.
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A PROGRAM TO PLAN AND PROMOTE URBAN AND COMMUNITY PORESTRY.
- (A) ANY URBAN COMMUNITY PORESTRY PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE ADMINISTERED FROM FUNDS PROVIDED IN ITS BUDGET. ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT, BY APPROPRIATE RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE, MAY IMPLEMENT A LOCAL URBAN PORESTRY PROGRAM WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION OR FNTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
- (B) (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ACCEPT FEDERAL FUNDS AND MAY PROVIDE COST SHARE PUNDS TO COOPERATIVE GOVERNMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTERING ANY URBAN COMMUNITY FORESTRY PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
