1. CATEGORY 1 - "INSTRUCTIONAL

SALARIES"

INCLUDES EXPENDITURES FOR SALARIES AND WAGES FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF TEACHERS, AIDES AND STUDENT SUPPORT STAFF, ACTIVITIES DEALING DIRECTLY WITH THE TEACHING OF STUDENTS. THE INTERACTION BETWEEN TEACHER AND STUDENTS, OR THE WELL-BEING OF STUDENTS. TEACHING MAY BE PROVIDED STUDENTS IN A SCHOOL CLASSROOM, IN ANOTHER LOCALE SUCH AS A HOME OR HOSPITAL, AND IN OTHER LEARNING SITUATIONS SUCH AS THOSE INVOLVING COCURRICULAR ACTIVITIES. IT MAY ALSO BE PROVIDED THROUGH SOME OTHER APPROVED MEDIUM SUCH AS TELEVISION, RADIO, TELEPHONE, AND CORRESPONDENCE.

A. REGULAR PROGRAMS

INSTRUCTIONAL ACTIVITIES DESIGNED PRIMARILY TO PREPARE STUDENTS FOR ACTIVITIES AS CITIZENS AND FAMILY MEMBERS.

LEARNING EXPERIENCES DESIGNED TO DEVELOP KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS TO MEET IMMEDIATE AND LONG-RANGE EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES OF ADULTS WHO, HAVING COMPLETED OR INTERRUPTED FORMAL SCHOOLING, HAVE ACCEPTED ADULT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

D. SUPPORT SERVICES - STUDENT

THOSE ACTIVITIES WHICH ARE DESIGNED TO ASSESS AND IMPROVE THE WELL-BEING OF STUDENTS AND TO SUPPLEMENT THE TEACHING PROCESS.
