AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Home Financing

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$10,000,000~~ ~~\$5,000,000~~ ~~\$10,000,000~~ \$7,500,000, the proceeds to be used to provide mortgage money for disadvantaged and low-income citizens of Maryland; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 571.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State debt in the amount of \$7,500,000 to be used to provide mortgage money for disadvantaged and low-income citizens of Maryland.

Senate Bill 358, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, 1979, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 571.
