FOR the purpose of altering the distribution of percentages of certain mutuel pools under the authority of the Maryland Racing Commission; altering certain tax rates on certain money wagered at certain races; altering the percentage of allocation of certain mutuel pools to the Maryland Bred races in addition to Maryland Bred purses; and altering the percentage of allocation of certain mutuel pools by certain licensees to the Maryland-Bred Race Fund.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 611.
