This bill alters the distribution of receipts from the State's mile and half-mile race tracks.

Senate Bill 794, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, accomplishes the same purpose in a more comprehensive fashion.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 611.
