Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1504.

This bill removes the requirement of the present law under Article 23A, § 2(26) of the Code that a municipality, other than Baltimore City, must obtain approval from the voters of the municipality before the legislative body of the municipality may change the salaries of its elected members.

· Senate Bill 523, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, 1979, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1504.
