FOR the purpose of providing that certain employees provided for the Sheriff shall be subject to the County Labor Code for collective bargaining purposes; prehibiting certain-interference-inte-labor--practices;--immunizing the--Gounty--Executive-from-certain-charges-or-actions; and-celarifying--language altering certain training requirements of certain employees of the Sheriff's department; and making certain employees of the Sheriff's department subject to the Personnel Laws of the County.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1591.

This bill provides that certain employees of the Prince George's County Sheriff's office shall be subject to the County Labor Code for collective bargaining purposes.

Senate Bill 499, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1979, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1591.
