and 85,446 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 681, the said Chapter 681 of the Acts of 1977 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of the State of Maryland.

AN ACT concerning Prince George's County - Election of County Council. For the purpose of providing a certain method for the election of county council members in Prince George's County; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 349,794 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 682 and 108,351 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 682, the said Chapter 682 of the Acts of 1977 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of the State of Maryland.
