(Prince George's County)

Charter Amendment No. 2-78

Code of the Town of Cheverly, Maryland,
Changes in Section C-29 of the Charter
Portion thereof Entitled:
"Taxes: Levy, Collection, Assessments"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Cheverly, Maryland find it desirable to keep the penalty rate for late payment of real estate and business personal property taxes consistent with those set by Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, County Council of Prince George's County has adopted CB 157-1977 amending pertinent portions of the Prince George's County Code, 1975 Edition, to set the penalty rate at 1% of the amount of taxes overdue and in arrears for each month or fraction thereof until paid.
