AN ACT concerning

Shorelines

FOR the purpose of recodifying Section 15A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland, establishing a fill and bulkhead line and borrow area limit line as Section 3-101 of Subtitle 1, Bodies of Water, of the Title 3, Water Resources of the Natural Resources Article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland and repealing and re-enacting, with amendments, Section 15B of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland, providing for the establishment of a Shoreline Commission, prescribing powers and duties therefor, requiring permits for certain construction work along shorelines, prescribing procedures therefor, appeals from decisions of the Shoreline Commission and penalties for violation thereof.

Zoning

For the purpose of redefining the agricultural setback and further allowing provisions for agriculture, including feeding lots, dairy barns, agricultural lagoons, poultry or hog houses and non-commercial grain dryers in the M-1 Zone
