

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

In Washington County the hours during which the privilege conferred by every class of on-sale OR CLASS A (OFF-SALE) license may be exercised [shall be] ARE from 6 a.m. to 2 [o'clock] a.m. the following day. This section does not apply to holders of Class E licenses.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 73

(House Bill 1257)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Compensation of Jurors

FOR the purpose of specifying that payments to jurors in Somerset County on a per diem basis shall be considered expense money.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

8-106.

(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated in this section for each day he attends court as a juror in:

(20) Somerset County--\$15 EXPENSE MONEY; no mileage allowance; no overtime.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
