(M) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION FOR THE FORM OF A PETITION, VERIFICATION AND ENDORSEMENT OF SIGNATURES ON IT, NOTIFICATION TO THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS OF THE RESULTS, AND DETERMINATION OF THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE PETITION APPLY TO PETITIONS OF CANDIDATES FOR A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 109

(Senate Bill 312)

AN ACT concerning

State Employees - Judgments and Settlements

FOR the purpose of extending the provisions for payment of settlements and judgments against State employees to all employees and members of a community college board of trustees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 78A - Public Works

(d) (2) For the purposes of this section, the term "State employee" includes:

(iv) An employee or member of a community college board of trustees[, if the board does not provide liability insurance for such employees or members, and if the board is a participant in the State Insurance Trust Fund under Article 95];
