SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

8-710.

(a) Each applicant for a license or the renewal of a license under this part shall pay to the Administration an annual fee, based on the number of outdoor sign structures [that the licensee maintains], as follows:

(1) [50 or less structures -- \$100; and] TEN OR LESS STRUCTURES -- \$25;

(2) [Over 50 structures -- \$350.] ELEVEN TO 50 STRUCTURES -- \$100; AND

(3) OVER 50 STRUCTURES --\$350.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 130

(Senate Bill 841)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County Jail - Administration and Operation
