SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 22 - Washington County28-23A.

~~{A}~~ WHENEVER THE WASHINGTON COUNTY SANITARY COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT A MODIFICATION OF AN EXISTING RATE, CHARGE, LEVY, OR ASSESSMENT PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION IS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL:

(1) GIVE NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED MODIFICATION IN AT LEAST ONE NEWSPAPER CIRCULATED IN WASHINGTON COUNTY; AND
