

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

92.

In Anne Arundel County, notwithstanding any other provisions in this subtitle, the following restrictions, limitations and regulations shall be in effect:

(a) The hours during which sales of alcoholic beverages may be made under all Class A, B, C, D, [and yacht clubs in the eighth district licenses shall be] H, AND SPECIAL CLASS LICENSES from 6 a.m. until 2 a.m. of the day following, except that no licensed premises shall be permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at any time on Sunday without a special Sunday license, ~~and except that yacht clubs in the eighth election district shall not be required to have a special Sunday license; All Special Class Licenses are not required to have a Sunday license.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 177

(House Bill 988)

AN ACT concerning

Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Hours of Sale - Clubs)

FOR the purpose of limiting the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages in Kent County by a Class C beer, wine and liquor license; and correcting language.
