SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 1 - Rules of Interpretation

UNLESS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SPECIFICALLY PROVIDES THAT ~~THIS SECTION SHALL BE INAPPLICABLE TO A PARTICULAR ACT OR PROVISION OF THIS CODE~~ OTHERWISE IN A PARTICULAR STATUTE, ALL WORDS IN THIS CODE IMPORTING ONE GENDER INCLUDE AND APPLY TO THE OTHER GENDER AS WELL.
