

CHAPTER 200

(House Bill 1734)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages
(License Fees)

FOR the purpose of providing and altering certain fees for certain classes of alcoholic beverage licenses in Frederick County; altering certain minimum physical plant valuation amounts as determined by State and local assessments and taxation which are used as criteria for issuing certain licenses; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 10(g-2), 15(e-1), 25(b)(6) and (c)(7)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
