

(E) THE FIVE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS AND OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY FOR 1 YEAR PRIOR TO ELECTION TO OFFICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before this Act becomes effective it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of Queen Anne's County at the general election to be held in November of 1980. The Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Queen Anne's County shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum here required. There shall be printed on the ballots or ballot labels to be used at this election the title of this Act and underneath the title, on separate lines, a square or box to the right of and opposite the words: "For County Commissioner Elections" and a corresponding square or box to the right of and opposite the words "Against County Commissioner Elections" so that each voter of the county may designate his or her decision for or against the provisions of this Act. If a majority of the votes cast in the election are "For County Commissioner Elections" the provisions of this Act shall become effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes cast in the election are "Against County Commissioner Elections" the provisions of this Act shall be of no effect and null and void.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That subject to the provisions of Section 2 herein and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum therein required, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1979.

#### CHAPTER 205

(House Bill 1782)

AN ACT concerning

Caroline County - Roads

FOR the purpose of providing in Caroline County that the County Roads Board may levy annual benefit or front foot assessments against nonabutting property for work done along private roads under certain conditions.
