SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s)-1-through-5,-inclusive,-and-8-of Chapter 972 of-the-Acts-of-the-General-Assembly-of 1977-be repealed: chapter(s) of the Acts of the General Assembly be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Chapter 972 of the Acts of 1977

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the General Assembly shall continue to evaluate the cost effectiveness of the driver education program in the State of Maryland and the validity of continuing State support of this program. If no action to the contrary is taken by the General Assembly by July 1, [1979] 1983, Sections 1 through 5 of this Act shall take effect July 1, [1980] 1984.
