CHAPTER 252

(Senate Bill 313)

AN ACT concerning

Senatorial Scholarships

FOR the purpose of specifying certain institutions and schools at which a senatorial scholarship may be used.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 18-405(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Education

18-405.

- (a) A senatorial scholarship may be used [for]:
- (1) IF THE CURRICULUM IS APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION AT A DEGREE GRANTING INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION OR A HOSPITAL DIPLOMA SCHOOL FOR TRAINING REGISTERED NURSES #F-THE-GURR#GULUM-#6-APPROVED-BY THE-STATE-BOARD-FOR-HIGHER-EDUCATION; and
- (2) FOR educational expenses as defined by the State Scholarship Board, including:
  - [(1)] (I) Tuition and mandatory fees; and
  - [(2)] (II) Room and board.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
