For the purpose of this subtitle, the following words or phrases, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

(a) The term "beauty culture" includes any and all work done for compensation by any person which work is generally and usually performed by so-called hairdressers, cosmetologists, cosmetologists aides, cosmeticians, wig stylists not licensed as barbers, beauticians or beauty culturists and demonstrators of beauty preparations or equipment, and however denominated in so-called hairdressing and beauty shops, which work is for the embellishment, cleanliness and beautification of hair, such as arranging, dressing, curling, [waiving] WAVING, permanent [waiving] WAVING, cleansing, cutting, singeing, arching of eyebrows, dyeing of eyebrows and eyelashes, bleaching, coloring, or similar work thereon and thereabout, and the removal of
