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~~{b} The State Lottery {Commission} AGENCY shall implement the provisions of this section by the adoption of rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act governing the issuance and use of bonds and the award of interest thereon, subject to the requirements of this section.~~

{J} SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION, AMEND, REPEAL, OR SUPPLEMENT THE RULES FROM TIME TO TIME AS HE DEEMS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.

FOR ~~the purpose of providing a Carroll County real property tax credit during certain periods and at certain rates for certain property located in Carroll County~~ permitting the Carroll County Commissioners to grant certain real property tax exemptions; requiring that the exemptions apply solely to county taxation; and creating certain limitations.
