

AND FOR WHOM AN EXCEPTION WAS GRANTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978-1979 WHOSE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS ARE DOMICILED IN THE COUNTY.

(2) Notwithstanding [the foregoing] PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SECTION, for fiscal year [1978-1979] ~~1980-1981~~ 1979-1980 only, the State Superintendent [of Schools may] SHALL allow a HANDICAPPED child to remain in a [day care] DAY-CARE center ~~under--the--jurisdiction--of--the---Mental Retardation--Administration~~ [upon] ON application for good cause by the county [or Baltimore City] superintendent. The application for [such] GOOD cause may include [, but is not limited to,] the lack of:

- (I) [available] AVAILABLE budget funds;
- or
- (II) [the lack of appropriate] APPROPRIATE alternate school placement.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
