SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Education

16-104.

(i) (1) The board shall coordinate relationships among the community colleges to:

[[1]] (I) Assure the widest possible educational opportunities for students in this State;

[[2]] (II) Facilitate the transfer of students between the community colleges and the University of Maryland, the State universities and colleges, and other institutions of higher education; and

[[3]] (III) Assure the most efficient use of State money.

(2) THE BOARD MAY:

~~{i}~~ DESIGNATE ANY COMMUNITY COLLEGE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM AS A STATEWIDE OR REGIONAL PROGRAM, AND.
