- (a) A manufacturer, distributor, or factory branch may not refuse to deliver new [Class A] MOTOR vehicles, [new Class B vehicles,] or new two-stage vehicles, as the case may be, to a licensed dealer, in reasonable quantities and within a reasonable time after receipt of a written order, if:
- (1) The manufacturer, distributor, or factory branch specifically advertises that these vehicles are available for immediate delivery; and
