SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

21-1205.

- (a) Each person operating a bicycle on a roadway shall:
- (1) Ride SHALL RIDE as near to the right side of the roadway as practicable AND SAFE, except when making or attempting to make a left turn, when operating on a one-way street, or when passing a stopped or slower moving vehicle; [and]
- TRAFFIC IS UNIMPEDED;
- {2}--Exercise (3) SHALL EXERCISE due care when
 passing a vehicle[.]; AND
- (3)--A-BICYCLIST,-WHEN-DISMOUNTED,-IS-CONSIDERED A-PEDESTRIAN,-HOWEVER,-HE-MAY-REMAIN-ON-THE-RIGHT-SIDE-OF THE-HIGHWAY:
- {b}--Persons--operating--bieyeles--in--a-public-bieyele
 area-OR-ON-A-SHOULDER-may-not-ride-more--than--two--abreastPersons-operating-bieyeles-on-a-{highway}-ROADWAY-shall-ride
 in-single-file-
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
