


 Wills heretofore by me made, and I do constitute this as my last Will
 and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
 this sixteenth day of December Anno Dom 1781.

 mind, memory & Understanding, and that they these deponents together with
 James Pearce the other subscribing witness within named subscribed their
 names as witnesses to this Will in the presence, and at the request
 of the Testator, and in the presence of each other.
