


son of my Sister Sarah Hinward to him and his heirs

 of this my last Will and Testament, Revoking & disannulling all  
 former Wills by me made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal the ~~twelfth~~ thirty first day of December  
 Anno Domini 1784.

 named sign & seal this Will, and that they heard him publish  
 pronounce and declare the same to be his last Will and Testament  
 and that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their Apprehensions  
 of sound disposing mind memory and Understanding, and that they  
 respectively subscribed their names as Witnesses to this Will, in the  
 presence, and at the Request of the Testator, and in the presence of each other.
