And first my Will is that my just debts be punctually paid, and the residue of my Estate I give & dispose ^{herefore} of in manner following.

1^{ly} I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Rachel Semans my now dwelling plantation and Land called Bright Helmston, likewise my land called Pierces Meadows during her Widowhood, but at her Marriage or decease, my Will is that my Grand Son Arthur Semans shall have & enjoy all the aforesaid Lands Excepting to my said Wife her Lawfull Dowry in case of her Marriage, and when the said Arthur Semans shall arrive to the age of twenty one years of age the above Lands to be then at his disposal him and his heirs or assigns for ever.

2^{ly} I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca Williams two pounds current passing money as her full share of my personal Estate to be paid her by my Executors hereafter named.

3^{ly} I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Wood two pounds
