

Signed Sealed published and declared by the Testator up as his
 last Will and Testament in presence of us who subscribed our names
 as Witnesses hereto in presence of the said Testator and at his Request
 W^m Ringgold, Thomas Anderson, Peregrine Ringgold
 May 3. 1785. Then came William Ringgold and Thomas Anderson
 two of the Subscribing Witnesses to the within last Will & Testament
 of James Anderson late of Kent County deceased, and severally made Oath
 on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that they did see the Testator
 therein named sign and Seal this Will, and that they heard him
 publish, pronounce, and declare the same to be his last Will & Testament;
 that at the time of his so doing, he was to the best of their Apprehensions
 of sound disposing mind, Memory, and Understanding; and that
 they together with Peregrine Ringgold the other Subscribing Witness
 to this Will subscribed their names in the presence, and at the
 Request of the Testator, and in the presence of each other.
