In the Name of God Amen I Robert Field of Whitehill in
the Township of Mansfield County of Burlington and Province of West
New Jersey, being in good health and perfect mind and memory on
the first day of September one thousand seven hundred and seventy four
make this my last Will and Testament in manner following. I resign my
Soul to its Creator in humble hopes of its future happiness as in the
disposal of abeing infinitely good, and my Body to the Dust from whence
I came to be buried in a decent manner by my Executors hereafter
named, and my Will that all my just Debts and funeral charges be
first paid and discharged as soon as possible after my decease
Inprimis I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Field three hundred
Acres of Land the North westerly part of my Estate at White Hill joining
the River Delaware ~~cececececececececece~~ (sic in Record) to be
divided from the remainder by a South West and North East line,
wherever it may fall out including my mansion House, Bakehouse,
Wharfs and stores, and Lots I bought of Richard Brown, the House, Barn
and part of the plantation I bought of Stacy Potts with all the
appurtenances thereto belonging as soon as he arrives to the age
Twenty one years, he yielding and paying unto his Mother if alive
