And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my good friends the said William Merritt and John Lamb Joint Executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking and annulling all former Wills by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Eighty and five
