last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore  
by me made as witness my hand and Seal this Twenty first  
day of November Seventeen hundred and Eighty three

her fires sufficient for the said House or part of a house, and Desire  
my son Simon not to disturbe her my said Daughter during the  
said Time of her Single life, but suffer her to Occupy the same with  
her own person and such attendance as she may think fitt to employ
