At the same time came John Moore Jun<sup>r</sup> and W<sup>m</sup> Gibbons the two Subscribing Witnesses to the above Codicil to the within last Will and Testament of Joseph Wickes late of Kent Co<sup>ty</sup> deced, and severally made oath on the Holy Evangelis, that they did see the Testator herein named sign and seal the same as a Codicil to his last will & Testament that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their apprehensions of sound disposing mind Memory and understanding and that they respectively subscribed their names as Witnesses to this Codicil in the presence and at the request of the Testator in the presence of each other
