make and Ordain this to be my last will and Testament in

1st First I Give and Bequeath unto my son Ralph Miller as
Legacies one Negro man called Tom, one Negro Boy called
Jack, one Negro Girl called Rose, and one Negro Girl called Jane,
and there Increase, one young young Horse called America,
one Mare Ten years old called Nancy, one Mare called
Jenny, one Mare called Nancy, Six Cows and Six Calves, Six
Ewes and Six Lambs, Two Sows and Ten Pigs, one Feather
Bed and furniture, Six Silver Table Spoons, one Silver Soup
Spoon, Five Silver Tea Spoons, one pair of Silver Tea tongs,
Ten pewter plates, Two pewter dishes, Twelve earthen
plates, Two Walnut Tables, one looking Glass, one Silver
Watch, one House clock, one Gun, and my Will and
my desire is that my son Ralph Miller be at full
