Phil for the term of Nine years and Tom for Eleven years from the date hereof, after the Expiration of which time they shall be Hired out for the term of Five years each, and the Moneys to be received Annually for Hire of them, and kept by my Executor for the use and benefit of the said Negroes Phil & Tom, to be paid to each of them at the Expiration of the afo<sup>d</sup> Five years and not before, It is my Will and desire that the afo<sup>d</sup> Negroes Tom, and Phil, shall at the Expiration of the afo<sup>d</sup> Five <sup>Years</sup> become to all intents and purposes free Men, and clear from any person whatsoever, I Give and Devise unto my two Neices daughters of my Brother John Peacock named Mary and Cassandra Fifty pounds Current Money each, on the same terms that I have heretofore Given my other Nephews and Neices — And lastly I Constitute and appoint Richard Peacock Sen<sup>r</sup> my whole and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament — I Witness whereof I have hereto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Domini 1706 —
