


In the Name of God Amen I John Timms of Kent County

 3^{dly} I do Constitute my Daughter Hannah Timms Executrix
 of this my last will and Testament, Lastly I do make and
 ordain this to be my last will and Testament Revoking and
 Disannulling all other will or Wills whatever as Witness my
 Hand and Seal this 15th day of November 1786 — — —

Decem^{er}, 23rd, 1786 Then came John Ricketts and W^m Kennard two
 of the Subscribing witnesses to the within last Will and Testament of
 John Timms late of Kent County deceased and severally made oath on the
 Holy Evangelis of Almighty God that they did see the Testator therein
 Named sign and Seal this Will, and that they heard him publish
 pronounce and declare the same to be his Last will and Testament
 that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their apprehensions
 of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding, and that
 Cha^s Groome the other Subscribing witness was present at the same
 time and signed his Name as a Witness to this Will together with
 these deponents in the presence and at the Request of the Testator
 and in the presence of each other — —
