

And Lastly. I do hereby Nominate constitute, and appoint, my Loving Wife, my whole and Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling, all former Will and Wills by me heretofore made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty Second day of November in the Year of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and eighty Six. 1786 — — — — —

February 17th 1787, Then came Zorobabel French and W^m French two of the Subscribing Witnesses to the within last Will and Testament of John Whittington late of Kent County, deced and severally made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that they did see the Testator therein Named sign and Seal this Will, and that they heard him Publish Pronounce and declare the same to be his last Will and Testament, that at the Time of his so doing he was to the best of their Apprehensions of Sound and disposing Mind memory and Understanding, and that Abednego Maffy the other Subscribing Witness was present at the same time and signed his Name as a Witness to this Will, together with these deponants in the presence and at the Request of the Testator and in the presence of each other — — — — —
