

this sixth day of February Anno Dom. 1788

May 29<sup>th</sup> 1788, then came Mar. Tilden and J<sup>r</sup>. Swift the subscribing Witnesses to the within last Will and Testament of Dorcas Moore late of Kent County deced, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that they did see the testatrix therein named sign and Seal this Will and that they heard her publish, pronounce and declare the same to be her last Will and Testament, that at the time of her so doing she was to the best of their Apprehensions of sound and disposing Mind, memory and understanding and that they Respectively subscribed their Names as Witnesses to this Will in the presence and at the Request of the testatrix and in the presence of each other
